### John 1.1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness <u>has not</u> [can not and will not ever] overcome it.

### John 1.9,14

The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life."

John 6.66-67

After this many of his disciples turned back and no longer walked with him. So Jesus said to the twelve,

"Do you want to go away as well?"

<u>John 6.68</u> "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the <u>words of eternal life</u>."

Peter is right of course, but doesn't go far enough. It's not just that Jesus <u>has</u> the words of life... He <u>is</u> the Word of Life.



# Jesus is asking about the hidden motives of the heart...

But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts?" (Mt 9.4) "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" (*Mt* 14.31) "Why put me to the test, you hypocrites?" (*Mt 22.18*) "Why do you trouble the woman? For she has done a beautiful thing to me." (Mt 26.10) "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Mt. 27.46)

Why does Jesus ask <u>why</u> so often? (After all, it's not as if He doesn't know the answer)

Jesus is asking about the hidden <u>motives</u> of the heart...

So that we might become more aware of <u>Why we do what we do</u>.

O LORD God, let your word to David my father be now fulfilled, for you have made me king over a people as numerous as the dust of the earth.

<u>Lk 6.46-49</u>..."Why do you call me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do what I tell you? <u>Everyone who comes to me and hears</u> <u>my words and does them</u>, I will show you what he is like: he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and <u>laid the foundation on the rock</u>.

<u>What is the Word of Life to God?</u> <u>Rock</u>

<u>Lk 6.46-49</u>... And when a flood arose, <u>the stream broke</u> <u>against that house and could not shake it</u>, <u>because it had</u> <u>been well built</u>. But the one who hears and does not do them is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the ruin of that house was great."

<u>Mt 13.18-23</u>... "Hear then the parable of the sower: When anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what has been sown in his heart. This is what was sown along the path.

<u>What is the Word of Life to God?</u>



<u>Mt 13.18-23</u>... As for what was sown on rocky ground, this is the one who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy, yet he has no root in himself, but endures for a while, and when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the word, immediately he falls away.

<u>*Mt* 13.18-23</u>... As for what was sown among thorns, this is the one who hears the word, but the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and it proves unfruitful.

<u>Mt 13.18-23</u>... As for what was <u>sown on good soil</u>, this is the one who <u>hears the word and understands it</u>. He indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundredfold, in another sixty, and in another thirty."

<u>1 Peter 1.23</u>...since you have been born again, <u>not of perishable seed but of imperishable</u>, <u>through the living and abiding word of God</u>.
