 $\begin{array}{c} Love \ of \ God - \ _{Jesus \ Christ} \\ Life \ of \ God - \ _{Holy \ Spirit} \\ Light \ of \ God - \ _{glorious \ Father} \end{array}$

Christianity (specifically the Trinity) answers people's most fundamental and pressing questions about themselves:

Who am I? (past)
Why am I here? (present)
Where am I going? (future)

Who am I?

I am a beloved child of God.

The Love of God (in Jesus) answers the most fundamental question about identity.

Why am I here?

The chief end of man is to glorify God and [by] enjoying Him forever.

The Life of God (in the Holy Spirit) answers the most fundamental questions about purpose.

Where am I going?

As we behold the glory of the Lord, we are being transformed in order to shine God's light to those around us. (2 Cor 3.18 and Mat 5.16)

The Light of God (in the Father) answers the most fundamental question about vision.

Who am I? (past)
Why am I here? (present)
Where am I going? (future)

But, these questions seem very egocentric.

Do questions like these reveal our Narcissism? (Here I am to worship...)
