




What is visible light?

Electromagnetic radiation that is perceivable by the normal human eye as <u>colors</u> between red and violet, having <u>frequencies</u> between 400 terahertz and 790 terahertz and <u>wavelengths</u> between 750 nanometers and 380 nanometers.

C.S. Lewis (Letters to Malcolm)

This heavenly fruit is instantly redolent of the orchard where it grew. This sweet air whispers of the country from whence it blows. <u>It is a message</u>. We know we are being touched by a finger of that righthand at which there are pleasures for evermore.

C.S. Lewis (Letters to Malcolm)

There need be no question of thanks or praise as a separate event, something done afterwards. To experience the tiny <u>theophany</u> is itself to adore.

[<u>Theophany</u>: a visible manifestation of God to humankind]

C.S. Lewis (Letters to Malcolm) Gratitude exclaims, very properly, 'How good of God to give me this.' Adoration says, 'What must be the quality of that Being whose far-off and momentary <u>coruscations</u> are like this!'

[coruscation: to sparkle like a diamond]

C.S. Lewis (Letters to Malcolm)

Definition of God's Light Psalm 119.130

The <u>unfolding of your words</u> gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

How does an understanding of the nature of visible light help us "unfold" God's Word?

<u>Color</u> – seeing <u>beauty</u> and <u>variety</u> in the Word. <u>Wavelength</u> – appreciating the <u>length</u> that God has gone to awaken our hearts to the glory of His Word.

Frequency – recognizing how <u>often</u> God brings His Word to "bear" in life's circumstances.

For what purpose did God shine His Light in our hearts?

Definition of God's Light 2 Corinthians 4.6-7

For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts <u>to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God</u> in the <u>face of Jesus Christ</u>.

But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that <u>the surpassing power belongs to God and</u> <u>not to us</u>.

Are you experiencing an ever increasing contrast between <u>God's glory</u> and your jar of clay?

Definition of God's Light 1 Timothy 6.15-16 ...our Lord Jesus Christ...He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom <u>no one has ever seen or can see</u>. To him be honor and eternal dominion. Amen.

Definition of God's Light Exodus 33.18-23

Moses said, "Please show me your glory." And God said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'The LORD.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. But," he said, "you cannot see my face, for man shall not see me and live."



VS.


<u>Communicable Attributes</u> (shared) – people primarily see these in <u>us</u>



Incommunicable Attributes

Omnipresent God is <u>present everywhere</u> at all times.

Psalm 139.7-10...Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me.



1 John 3.20...for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything.

Definition of God's Light Incommunicable Attributes Sovereign God has the power, wisdom and <u>authority</u> to do anything He chooses. Psalm 103.19... The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

Definition of God's Light Incommunicable Attributes Self-existent God is the uncreated Creator.

Isaiah 46.9...for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me.

Definition of God's Light Incommunicable Attributes Immutable God does not and <u>cannot change</u>. Malachi 3.6...*For I the LORD do not change;*

therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed.

Definition of God's Light Romans 1.19-20






