What is Physical Darkness?

Darkness is simply the absence of light...

Like cold being the absence of heat We cannot add cold — we remove heat

Darkness is never unpaired from light!

Always remember darkness is not a "substance" that can be <u>added</u>— it is only what remains after light is <u>subtracted</u>.

Darkness exists in varying amounts...

Less Light

More Light

What's the difference?

The difference is merely one of perception!

A mental battle of changing our perception.

Is an eclipse something to fear?
