(depends)

- 1. <u>positive</u>: showing a willingness to take surprisingly bold risks...
- 2. <u>negative</u>: showing an impudent lack of respect...

Should we not also pray that God would show us His glory?

Let's be willing to take a surprisingly bold risk!

What is the glory of God?

OT Glory: Hebrew: "kabod"

This word means "weighty" or "to be heavy"

NT Glory: Greek: "doxa"

This word has a wide range of meanings in the NT, corresponding closely to splendor, brilliance - from the base meaning of the awesome light that radiates from God's presence and is associated with his acts of power; honor, praise, speaking of words of excellence and assigning highest status to God.

God's glory in Scripture...

1. It's why we were made.

Isaiah 43.7

everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made.

2. Something that will change us...

Exodus 33.18

Moses said,
"Please show me your glory."

Exodus 34.29-30

When Moses came down from Mount Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God. Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him.

3. Something illuminating...

Revelation 21.22-23

And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb.

4. Something that offers freedom...

Romans 8.21

that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the <u>freedom</u> of the glory of the children of God.

5. Something transformational...

2 Corinthians 3.18

And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another.

6. Something we have a small hint of in creation...



(that is meant to be <u>appreciated</u> and <u>delighted in</u> and <u>enjoyed</u> and <u>worthy of praise</u>)



Jonathan Edwards understood glory as a <u>threefold</u> movement.


First, as its source, glory is God's inner life of love.



As the Father and Son love and delight in one another in the Spirit, the life they know among themselves is the life of glory.


This is God's fullness.

God's life is infinitely dynamic three persons partaking in one another and loving each other infinitely.




Second, when God decides to create and relate to his creation, he does so by pouring forth his glory.

God is the infinite spring who pours himself forth in streams of glory.



God communicates a true knowledge and sight of himself in his Son that causes people to know and love him in return.

He also gives his Spirit, his own love, that we would love him in return.



The third tier of glory, therefore, entails God's people participating in his glorification


knowing God and pouringforth love to him in return.

God's glory pulls us into a relationship of love with God.

So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.



Rather than being an extension of salvation, we end up with an advanced form of self-help.




The goal of spiritual disciplines is often explained as a transformation of character.

Holiness is not in your power.




The means of grace are actions that help us focus more fully on God, recognizing that God is the fountain from which all grace flows.

But it's vital to remember that you were created to live for a greater, more glorious glory -


The glory of God!
