





What are Satan's <u>Purposes</u> in your Marriage?

In the spirit of C.S. Lewis' "Screwtape Letters", How can we help accomplish Satan's purposes?

- 1. Begin to question God's goodness in your life.
- 2. Compare your spouse to another.
- 3. Keep all conflict buried and unresolved.
- 4. Never look for the sin behind the sin.
- 5. Never say: "I was wrong will you forgive me?"
- 6. Never try to see things from her point of view.
- 7. Never be open or <u>vulnerable</u> or seek out help.
- 8. Above all, do not read your Bible or pray together.

Fear:

"to be awed before the reality of"

Paul assumes you have a spirit created ability to be unselfish.

The main problem in any marriage is self-centeredness.

The gospel is:

"You are more sinful and evil and weak than you ever dared believe... but you are more <u>valued</u> and <u>accepted</u> and loved than you ever dared hope."

Permissive message:

"This is a great arrangement, God enjoys forgiving sin and I enjoy committing it."

Legalistic mindset:

"I know I'm in God's will, because I'm miserable."

The Christian repents out of gratitude for what Christ has done and out of a desire to be like Christ.

When you have gospel-love, it makes you more able to repent.

Strong and yet humble...

able to put the needs of your spouse above your own.
